The Photo-Session

Your pet will be the star, and everything about the session will bring out their awesome best. From the location we choose, to the treats or rewards along the way, your pet will know it's "All About Me!!". We'll take all the time necessary to ensure your pet enjoys the experience and has every opportunity to shine like a super-model, and we'll all have a great time!

For the location, we have so many possibilities here in SEQ; dreamy forests, stunning beaches, gorgeous dog friendly parks, or perhaps your pet is more an urban city-style type. We can even have the session at your home, if appropriate.

But top priority is always the safety and comfort of your pet. The session will take place in a safe environment, and if outdoors, your pet will remain on a lead throughout the session. Yes, the magic of digital imaging will make the lead disappear in the final photos!

We also need to be accompanied by one handler per pet - ideally someone who your pet is already familiar with, to ensure that your pet is as happy and relaxed as possible. If that isn't possible, a professional handler can be arranged.

The Pre-Session Planning Appointment

The pre-session planning appointment ensures your final artwork will be exactly as you want it.

First we'll talk about everything that makes your pet unique and be sure that we plan something that suits their character. Then we'll uncover your visions of the photos and artwork that you're dreaming of. Finally, we'll decide on a location that brings that all together perfectly - in your pet's favourite park or garden, at a beautiful beach, a glorious Queensland forest walk- the possibilities are endless.

Pre-session appointments can be held in the comfort of your own home, which also gives us the opportunity for your pet to meet his/her new best photographer friend, or if you prefer, on a video call.

Artwork

Special memories are worthy of special treatment, and that's what they get when they are printed by Australia's top, professional photographic printers. Museum grade canvases and fine art papers are combined with archival inks and acid free mounts to ensure that their colours don't fade. They are superb, and will continue to evoke awe, even when it's your grandchildren's children who are the ones to admire them.

At your artwork consultation appointment, about two weeks after your photo session, you'll see your photos in digital mockups of the product range, and you'll have the opportunity to see and touch product and framing samples, so you'll know exactly what you're getting. It's also a chance for us to make any final adjustments, such as cropping to make them exactly as you want them.

Framed Fine Art Prints

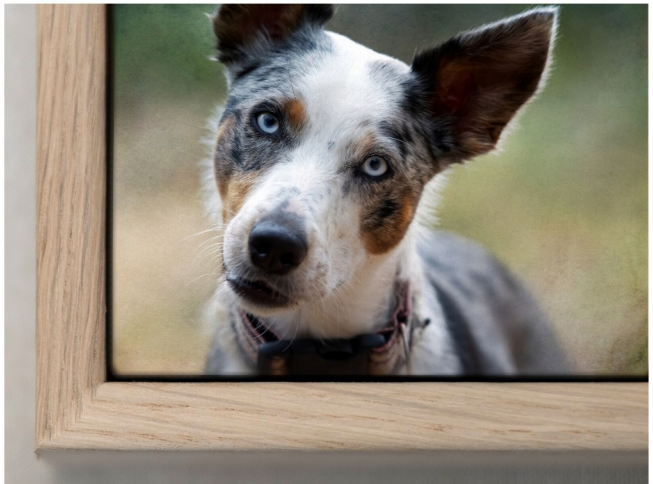
You'll be thrilled when you receive your favourite picture printed on matte or cotton rag fine art paper, and then perfectly mounted on an acid-free mat board and framed in your choice of frame moulding.

From start to finish, the highest quality products are brought together to create a stunning picture which you will love for many, many years to come.

Framed fine art prices start at \$415.

Your canvas wall art is printed on museum grade 450gsm archival canvas, with archival pigment inks, and a satin laminate is applied to provide UV, moisture and handling protection. It comes ready to hang with professional-grade hanging attachments. The classic stretched canvas looks great when combined into collections, or add a premium, double-profiled hardwood box frame in a range of colours to add depth and a fresh, modern look.

Prices for canvas prints start at \$260.

Collections and Montages

Brushed Frame Acrylics

When it's too hard to choose just one photo, a collection of prints in framed fine art or canvas offers savings on the original prices, while a framed montage is a fantastic way to tell your pet's story.

Collections start at \$702 for a triptych of 3 stretched canvas prints.

Shown in the picture is the "Cronulla" montage, available in four different frame sizes and a range of mouldings, starting at \$700.

Incredibly elegant, these beautiful frames feature brushed metal in rose-gold, black, or silver. The highest quality acrylic is used for the print, ensuring perfect colours and stunning clarity. Brushed Frame Acrylics are ready to hang, and are available in 30cm and 60cm circles, and 32cm and 62cm squares with rounded edges.

Pricing starts at \$490.

Matted Fine Art Sets

Your collection of fine art prints will be matted in an acid free mount and ready to go into a frame. Available in sets of five or ten, in two sizes to fit standard frame sizes. Add a double sided, hardwood timber folio box to your set of 10 prints, to both keep and display your pictures.

Matted fine art print collections start at \$435 for a collection of five matted prints. Individual matted prints are available for purchase with the Complete Mini and Club Mini packages.



Lumitiles

You'll love these little diamond-polished acrylic wonders- their visual impact and floating 3D effect is just fantastic, and they are free-standing so you can put them anywhere- coffee tables, bookshelves, window sills, your office desk- everywhere! They look great grouped together, so you can get collections of three of your favourite photos at a lower unit price.

Lumitile pricing starts at \$180.



High Resolution Digital Images

High resolution digital files can be purchased in sets of three, five or 10 or more images. They are supplied with a Photo Licensing Agreement for unlimited printing for personal use. Pricing starts at \$315 for a set of three images.

Photo sessions start with a complete package, and you can then add from a range of optional upgrades and pre-purchase savings.

Photo Session \$195

We'll work together on your project from start to finish, so the photo session fee includes all the necessary components to make it come together perfectly.

Standard inclusions are:
